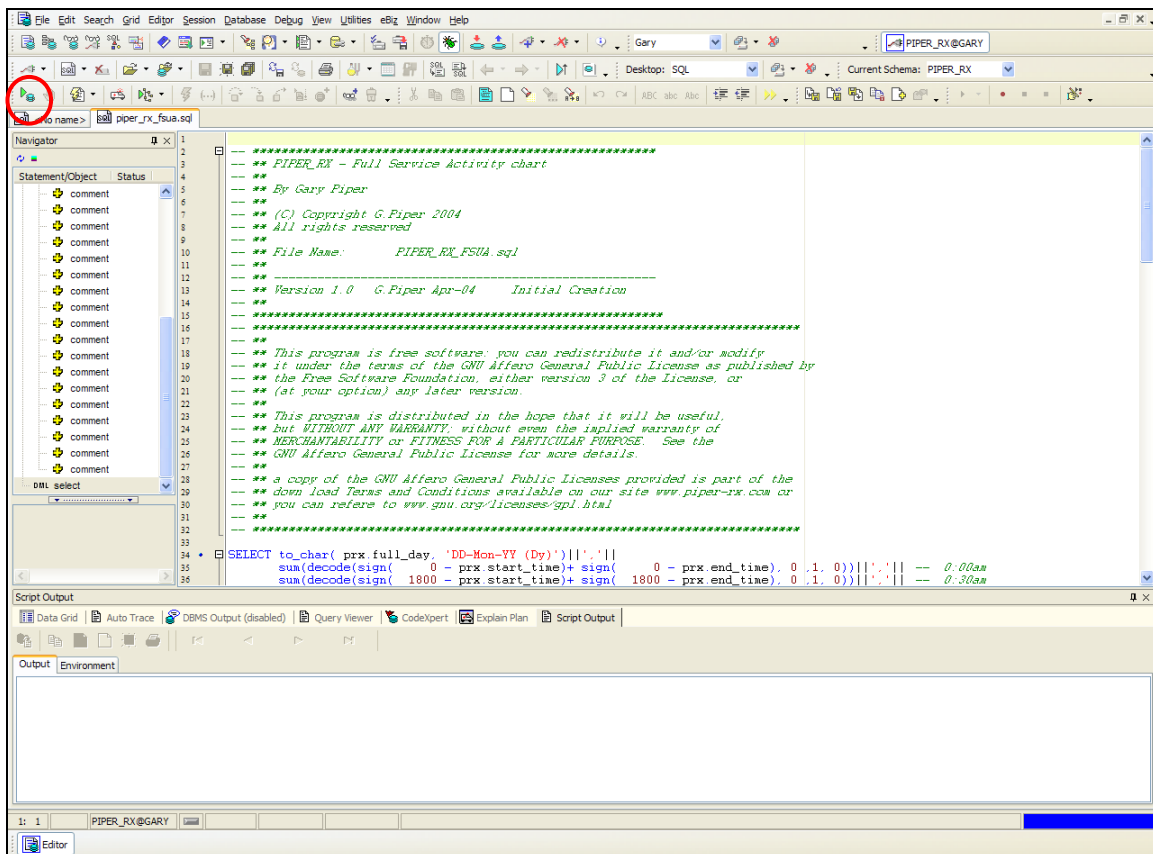

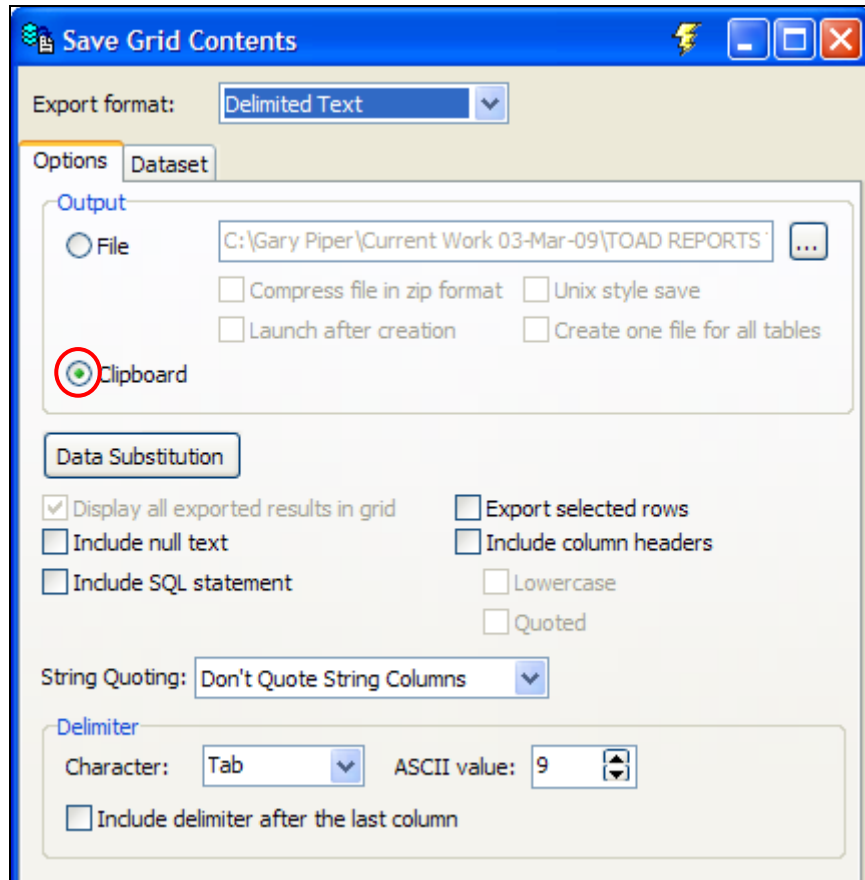
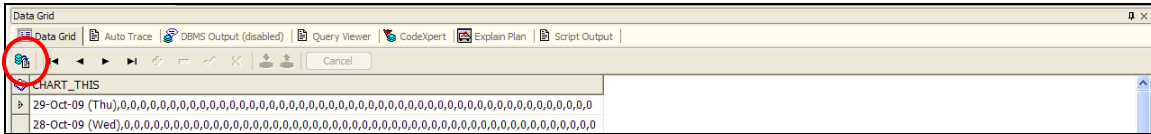
1 How to chart Full Service User Activity

Step 1: Launch TOAD and open the file [piper_rx_fsua.sql](#) the full service activity SQL

Step 2: Run the SQL as indicated in the screen shot below:



Step 3: Save the SQL results to a clipboard as indicated in the screen shot below:

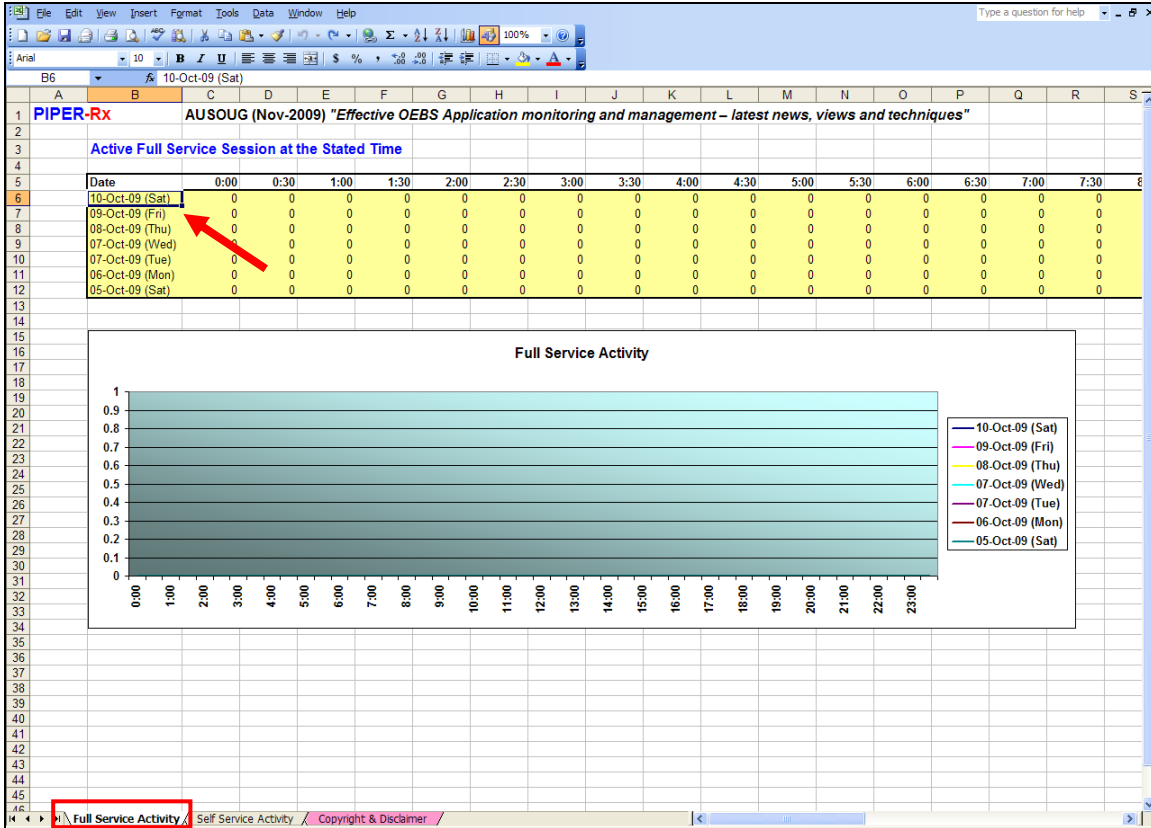


Step 4: Open the spreadsheet [oebs_user_activity.xls](#)

Step 5: Select the “Full Service Activity” Tab

Step 6: Place the cursor in the top left hand corner of the yellow section of the spreadsheet

Step 7: Paste the content of the clip board into the spreadsheet. The result should look similar to the screen shot below:



Step 8: You can now cut and paste the chart into any target document of your choosing. For example this could be a very handy addition to any monthly report you produce.

2 How to chart Self Service User Activity

The process is basically the same as for Full Service activity.

Repeat steps 1 – 8 of the process detailed in section 1 above with the following changes:

- use the self service activity SQL [piper_rx_ssua.sql](#)
- use the “Self Service Activity tab” in the spreadsheet
